



The **Flood Watch** issued on the 5th of April and updated on the 13th of April for the Crowe Valley watershed has been **CANCELLED, effective immediately**. This cancellation has been issued at 11:00 am, Wednesday, the 26th of April, 2017.

Water levels and flows have peaked from their spring highs and continue to recede at a steady rate, approaching summer levels throughout the watershed. Although the Crowe River and its tributaries are subsiding, the CVCA advises everyone to remain cautious around waterways as strong currents and cold water still pose a serious threat to public safety.

In addition, the CVCA would like to confirm the mild winter conditions, coupled with sufficient precipitation during the winter and early spring has sufficiently recharged aquifers throughout the watershed. Therefore, the CVCA has removed the Low Water Level One status as the watershed has returned to normal conditions for both surface and groundwater.
