ATTENTION BOATERS ON ROUND LAKE AND OAK LAKE

The Crowe Valley Conservation Authority is advising residents on Round Lake and Oak Lake that water levels remain lower than normal for this time of year. As a result, residents should consider removing their boats early this fall. Due to the hot, dry summer, Round Lake is currently 8 inches below its summer level regulated level and Oak Lake is 13 inches below its regulated summer level. These lake will remain lower than average until a significant amount of precipitation is received.

CVCA is also advising boaters/fishermen to use extreme caution while out on these lakes so their boats do not get damages from hidden rocks, shoals and other debris.
