CALLTO ORDER

The Chair, Catherine Redden, called the meeting to order at 9:30am.

Catherine Redden welcomed Mr. & Mrs. Mark Daprato to the meeting which was being held electronically by Google Meet.

CHAIR'S OPENING REMARKS

The Chair, Catherine Redden, informed the Watershed Advisory Board that a Hearing under Section 28 of the *Conservation Authorities Act* will be held with respect to Mr. Mark Daprato's application to construct a 1,431.5 square foot addition that wraps around the existing cottage and to move the septic system away from the lake and wetland on Chandos Lake.

Chair Catherine Redden gave the opening remarks as outlined in the hearing guidelines with respect to Ontario Regulation 159/06 and reviewed the procedure of the Hearing.

Staff Report – Robert Cole

Robert Cole reviewed the executive summary of the report, the policies that permit #178/20 does not comply with and the location of the proposed project.

The proposed addition to the dwelling does not meet policy requirements as it is above the maximum allowable size of the addition within the hazard. Robert informed the Board the applicant has tried to keep the size of the addition to a minimum by adhering to the minimum requirements for wheel chair accessibility. As well, by proposing to move the septic system actually brings the septic inline with the policy manual. The proposed addition meets all of the other five tests laid out in the policy manual.

Robert explained the flood elevation for Chandos lake and how a flood could effect this property. Robert recommended to the Watershed Advisory Board the application be approved with conditions. The conditions would include no future

additions be permitted and the sunroom be converted to a covered deck with screens instead of walls.

Applicant Report – Mr. Mark Daprato

Mr. Mark Daprato thanked the Board for their time. In addition to the circulated presentation, he informed the Board while designing the addition, he tried to keep the health of the lake in mind and decided to relocate the septic system as well as put the dwelling on piers to help reduce any negative impacts while meeting the needs of becoming wheel chair accessible for their son. Their main goal for the addition was to make a more enjoyable and accessible life for their son.

The Board thanked Mr. Daprato for his presentation, for their cooperation throughout the process and for their positive attitude toward the Conservation Authority and staff.

BOARD DISCUSSION

The Board discussed the application and the staff recommendations and the suggested conditions of the permit.

- 2. That the sun room be converted to a covered screened in deck.
