Regulations Officer Designation

Background

The Crowe Valley Conservation Authority has three staff in the Regulations and Planning Program in order to deliver the services of the program in a timely and efficient manner for the public. Recently a staff member of this team has resigned. Liam Bailey-McDade has been promoted to fill this vacancy.

Current Status

As a result of this promotion, Liam will need to be designated as a Regulations Officer for the CVCA. This designation will enable Liam to issue permit applications for development under *Ontario Regulation 41/24*.

Liam is currently taking the Provincial Offences Officer (P.O.O.) training and once he has completed the course and received a passing grade, he will need to be designated as a Provincial Offences Officer for the CVCA. This should be completed at the next available Board Meeting. The P.O.O. designation will allow Liam to investigate and issue violation notices and ultimately represent the CVCA at any related court proceedings.

Recommendation

That Liam Bailey-McDade be designated as a Regulations Officer for the Crowe Valley Conservation Authority.
